

The Fenderfest

The Fenderfest is a gathering for enthusiasts of bicycles from the golden era of bike manufacturing and their modern counterparts. It is inspired by the **French Fender Day** by Peter Weigle.

Of course, you can attend the Fenderfest without a bike, but if you want to participate in the group rides, you should bring your own bicycle.

If you want to display your bike, please remember to bring a **stand**. A quick search for “**bike stand**” online should help you find one. The bikes will be showcased all over the property. You are welcome to bring multiple bikes, but since space in front of the workshop is limited and was quite crowded last year, we kindly ask you to place **second and third bikes on the back meadow**.

Everyone attending can vote for the **most beautiful tandem** and the **most beautiful solo bike**. The winners will receive a **bike-related prize**. Voting cards will be available in the workshop.

This year, in the barn, there will also be:

- A **small flea market area** (max. 1.5m per person).
- A “**merchandise**” area where small businesses can sell T-shirts, hats, and other products.

- This year, there will already be **group rides on Saturday**.
- **7:00 PM:** Award ceremony with beer and grilled sausages by the campfire.
- A young punk band will make their debut performance.

June 1

- **11:00 AM:** Big communal breakfast.
- Afterwards, different **group rides**.

Accommodation & Catering

Everyone is welcome to **set up their tent on-site**.

- There will be **2 portable toilets (Dixi)** and **garden showers**.
- Various **car parking spots** are available around Groß Lüben (some suitable for camper vans).
- If you prefer more comfort, there are several accommodation options in **Bad Wilsnack** and nearby: bad-wilsnack.de.

We will provide the essentials:

- Water, beer, bread rolls, grilled sausages, a large vegan stew, and portable toilets.
- Therefore, we ask for a **€50 participation fee**, which must be paid in advance via bank

transfer or PayPal. You will receive further details in the registration confirmation email.

If you arrive on Friday, please take care of your own food. Alternatively, food and drinks will be available at the festival.
