

Liability Waiver for the Group Rides (Friday and Saturday)

Participation in the group rides as part of the Fenderfest is voluntary and at your own responsibility.

The rides take place in public traffic areas and lead along roads, bike paths, and, where applicable, unpaved routes. All participants are responsible for complying with applicable traffic regulations and for adapting their behavior to the respective traffic, weather, and route conditions.

Each participant is responsible for ensuring that their bicycle is in a roadworthy condition and that they are physically able to take part in the respective route.

The rides are not guided tours in the legal sense. They are group rides without any claim to guidance, supervision, or support by the organizer. Each participant moves independently in public traffic areas.

The organizer and all persons involved in the organization assume no liability for personal injury, property damage, or financial loss arising in connection with participation in the rides, unless such damage is caused by intentional or grossly negligent conduct on the part of the organizer.

This applies in particular to:

- accidents, falls, or injuries during the ride
- damage to one's own bicycle or personal equipment
- damage caused to other participants or third parties
- loss, damage, or theft of personal property

Each participant is responsible for having adequate insurance coverage (in particular private liability insurance and, if applicable, accident insurance).

We strongly recommend wearing a bicycle helmet during the rides. In case of an emergency, a helmet can prevent serious head injuries. Although wearing a helmet is of course a personal choice, we consider it a very good idea to ensure your own safety in such a simple way - and thereby also the safety of the group.

From Saturday evening onwards in Groß Lüben, there will be an event with music and catering. Event liability insurance is in place for this part of the event.

Parents or legal guardians are responsible for supervising their children and minors throughout the entire event. In particular, applicable youth protection regulations must be observed on Saturday evening.

By participating in the Fenderfest and the rides, all participants acknowledge and accept this liability waiver.
